2024 STATEWIDE PRIMARY AND ELECTION

QUICK FACTS!

- Federal, State, and Local offices will be on the ballot.
- Unaffiliated voters will have the option to choose which party primary they would like to participate in.
- All school board contests are non-partisan general elections and will be on the ballot for voters that are at least 18 years of age.
- Registered 17-year-olds who will be 18 by the date of the November 5th General Election will be able to participate in the primary election.
- The voter registration deadline is February 9th.
- Photo ID will be required to vote.

VOTE EARLY!

- Early voting is Feb. 15th - Mar. 2nd.
- Avoid long lines and vote early.
- Register and vote during the early voting period with proof of residency.

VOTE BY-MAIL!

- Request a no-excuse absentee-by-mail ballot fully online on or before February 27th.
- Track your ballot from the point of distribution until it is returned to the BOE.

VOTE ON ELECTION DAY!

- Election Day voting will occur on March 5th at your home precinct's polling place.
- The polls will be open from 6:30 a.m. - 7:30 p.m.
